



Scholarship Program 2018 Description

Eligibility:

To be considered:

- The applicant's primary residence must be located in a community under the ownership of Millennium Housing Corporation, Millennium Housing of California, or COACH of San Diego, Inc.
- The applicant must be planning to attend a post-secondary institution the following academic year.
- The applicant must be between the ages of 17 and 25.
- A completed application must be postmarked by August 3rd, 2018.
- Prior SPARC Scholarship recipients can reapply if still eligible.

Scholarship Terms & Conditions

The SPARC Scholarship Program will award scholarships of up to \$1,000. The number of scholarships awarded depends on program funding.

Recipients will be selected by a scholarship committee consisting of staff and Board Members of SPARC, Inc. The decisions of the committee are final and binding.

Scholarship recipients must enroll in and attend an accredited post-secondary education institution the academic year following their application submission. Funds will be paid to the recipient and must be used for school-related expenses. If a recipient does not comply with these requests they will be ineligible to reapply for the SPARC Scholarship Program in future years.

Supporting Documents

In addition to the application, applicants must also attach the following items:

- Transcript(s): If the applicant is entering his/her first year of college, a high school transcript is required. If the applicant is currently attending a post-secondary institution, a post-secondary transcript is required.
- Verification of Enrollment: Either a class schedule or acceptance letter. If applicant does not have verification of enrollment to attach to this application, include note of explanation. Note: funds will only be awarded after proof of enrollment has been submitted.
- Previous SPARC scholarship winners only: Include a brief explanation of how the prior SPARC scholarship funds were used.
- Essay Question: Applicants must write and submit an essay on one of the topics listed below

Essay Topics

- "If you could have dinner with any person, living or dead, who would it be and why? What questions would you ask them?"
- "Describe something you have done in the past year that has made a difference in your community, family, and/or school."
- "Describe the solutions you would propose to improve or resolve a current issue, such as health care, the economy, discrimination, or a current topic of your choice."

- “If you could transport yourself to any place in the world right now, where you go, what would you do, and why?”
- “Describe the most challenging obstacle you have had to overcome; discuss its impact and tell what you have learned from the experience.”

Essay must be:

- Typed
- 12 point font
- Approximately 700 words
- Applicant’s name on each page

Certification & Release

All applicants and, where appropriate, their parent or guardian, must sign the attached application, certifying that all information provided is true and complete to the best of their knowledge. Upon submission, applicants grant SPARC, Inc. the right to use any information contained in the application for the purpose of promoting and publicizing the Program, or as legally required or permitted by law.
